

The Family Matters Report for 2023 shows that the number of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children entering Out-of-Home Care continues to rise, exposing them to ongoing harm and trauma.



Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Children represent **42.8%** of the total number of children in OOHCAustralia but only represent **5.98%** of all children in Australia.
